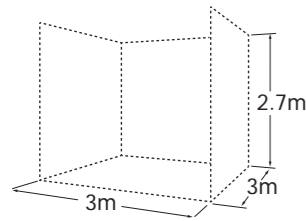

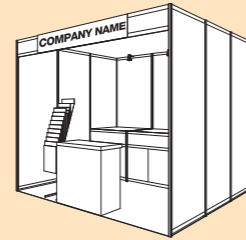

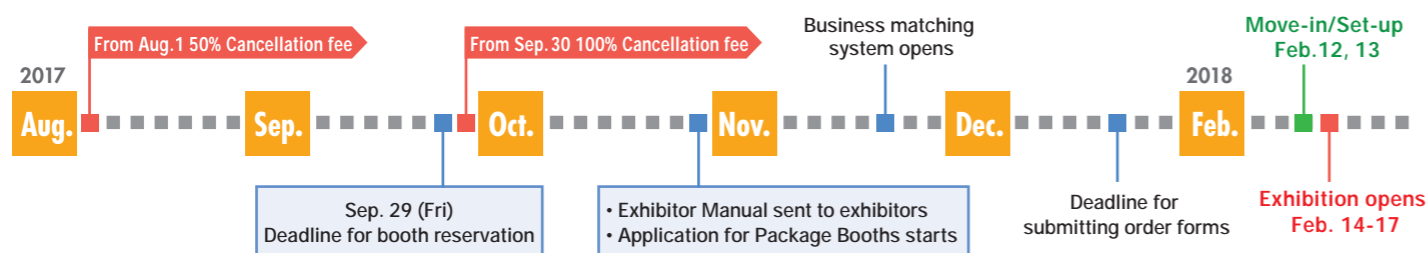


How to Apply / Schedule

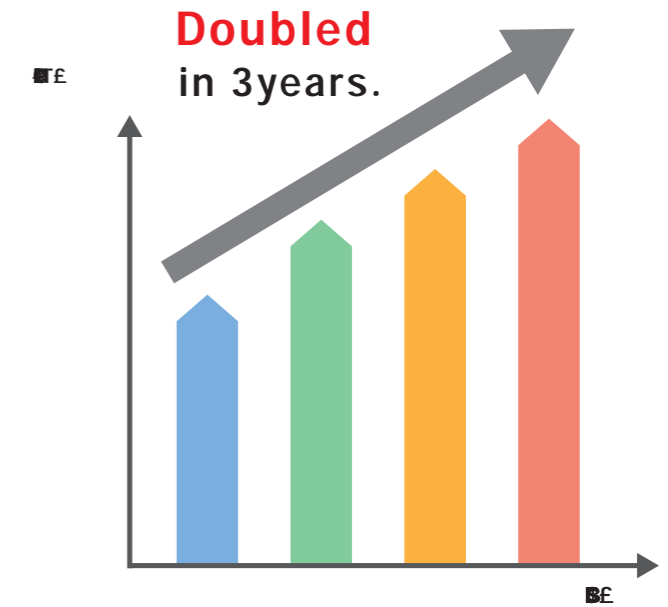
